

MISS COLUSA COUNTY SCHOLARSHIP PAGEANT

The Miss Colusa County Scholarship Pageant provides an opportunity to enhance your personal development in the areas of poise, self-confidence, communication skills, and good sportsmanship. The competition is *not* a beauty contest, but rather a program that fosters youth accomplishments, community service, academic achievement, and recognition for excellence. All rules and regulations are designed to make the pageant a fun and successful event for all involved.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Contestant must be between the age of 16 and in the 11th grade and not older than 19 as of June 1st of this calendar year.
2. Contestant must be a resident of Colusa County and the State of California for at least one year prior to the opening of the fair.
3. Contestant must agree to abide by all the rules and regulations of the Miss Colusa County pageant and Fair Board rules and regulations. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
4. Contestant must be single, not divorced, or had her marriage annulled. Contestant must not have been pregnant, in the past or present. Contestant must not have any convictions on record.
5. Miss Colusa County contestants, if not chosen as the winner, may compete in following years.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

1. Contestant must complete the official pageant application.
2. Parent or legal guardian must sign all applications if applicant is under the age of 18.
3. All applications must be in the Colusa County Fair Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on **April 17, 2014 by 5:00 p.m., or postmarked by that date.**
4. Applications are limited to the first ten entries received. Entries will be dated and stamped as received.

SPONSORS AND APPLICATION

1. Contestant and/or sponsors shall pay an application fee of \$100.00 per contestant. Checks are payable to the Colusa County Fair.
2. Sponsors will be announced on stage during the contestant's various areas of competition.
3. Fee must accompany the contestant's application.
4. Contestant applications that are not completed properly or accompanied by the application fee will not be accepted or processed.

COMPETITION ACTIVITIES

1. Contestant agrees to attend all related activities and rehearsals without exception.
2. Contestants shall make all appearances for publicity reasons and any other similar type appearances and rehearsals so designated by the pageant directors at their expense, unless other arrangements are made.
3. The new Miss Colusa County will be responsible for transportation arrangement to and from all activities and appearances at their expense, unless other arrangements are made.

LOST ARTICLES

Contestants understand that the competition management will not be responsible for lost or stolen articles during any pre-competition and/or competition activities.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE NEWLY CROWNED MISS COLUSA COUNTY

1. Winner agrees to attend all public appearances when asked by the Miss Colusa County Management.
2. If the contestant chosen as Miss Colusa County should for any reason not to be able to fulfill her reign, the first runner up will resume the title for the remainder of the year.
3. Winner agrees to only wear her sash and/or crown at approved appearances.

RULES AND QUALIFICATIONS

1. Contestant will appear in the Miss Colusa County Pageant at the Colusa County Fairgrounds on Thursday night of the Fair at 7:00 p.m, June 5, 2014.
2. Age limit – 16 and in the 11th grade and not older than 19 as of June 1st of this calendar year.
3. Entry fee is \$100.00 (payable to: 44th District Agricultural Association)
4. Entries are limited to residents of Colusa County, or any student living out of the County, but enrolled in a Colusa County School.
5. Contestant must never have been married, divorced, have had a marriage annulled or have had a child.
6. Contestant must fill out the Entry Form and Questionnaire and return to the Colusa County Fair Office, 1303 – 10th Street, Colusa CA 95932, **NO LATER THAN THURSDAY APRIL 17, 2014 BY 5:00 P.M.**
7. Practice will begin the middle of April with intensive rehearsals held during the weeks prior to the Fair, at which time full details and instructions will be given to the contestant.
8. To redeem scholarships, the recipient's name and ID # from the college or school in which they have enrolled must be provided to the Colusa County Fair Foundation which will forward the monies to that institution's financial aid/scholarship office for distribution.
